

Chesapeake District Cabinet Meeting
November 7, 2003

The Chesapeake District Cabinet meeting was held November 7, 2003 at the Radisson Fort Magruder, Williamsburg, Virginia. Guest and spouse of Cabinet members attended the evening dinner. After dinner District Governor Balderson presented each cabinet member with a polo style shirt inscribed with the district and members name.

A special meeting of the voting members was called by the Governor to take up two items of old business from prior meeting, Chesapeake Crab Pins and the Freedom Foundation program.

David Duke a member of the Varina club, that gave \$2500.00 toward the pin purchase, made a motion, seconded by Charlie Bell, past District Governor, that the pins be turned over to Alvin Loving, District Treasurer to be given to the club, one pin per member. That an additional 5, pins would be also be given to the club to hold for new members After the 5 pins are handed out additional pins could be requested by the club for new members as needed until the supply of pins are exhausted. Motion Passed.

Lloyd Hick, Youth Activities Coordinator, reported on his study of youth attending Freedom Foundation, at Valley Forge, costing \$450.00 not including transportation and a second option of starting a district program at Jamestown 4-H camp costing \$200.00. There would not be any transportation cost as the camp is located near enough for parents to transport children. Attendees would travel to Jamestown, Yorktown and Williamsburg steeped in history. A motion was made that the District start such a program. Lloyd reminded the members that volunteers would be needed in pairs of two to be determined by the number of youth attending. Motion passed.
